# Study

- Questionnaire survey
- 1733 adolescents from primary and secondary schools in Copenhagen, Aarhus and Odense with high density of "bilingual" pupils or adolescents with an "ethnic background other than Danish"
- 5,6% were immigrants from non-western countries
- 7,0% were descendants from non-western countries



### Definition of ethnic minorities

Statistics Denmark 2005:

#### *Immigrants and descendants from nonwestern countries.*



### Definition of ethnic minorities

• Origin country:

Defined from mother's country of birth. If this is Denmark, country of citizenship is used. These rules apply to the father if mother's data is unknown

• Western countries:

EU-countries, Andorra, Iceland, Liechtenstein, Monaco, Norway, San Marino, Switzerland, Vatican State, Canada, USA, Australia and New Zealand



### Definition of ethnic minorities

### Immigrant from a non-western country:


- Born in a non-western country
- Both parents are born in and/or have a citizenship from a non-western country

### Descendant from a non-western country:

- Born in Denmark
- Both parents are born in and/or have a citizenship from a non-western country


